Chairman Kimberley Emberg called to order the meeting of the Board of Selectmen at 8:33 AM.  
Selectmen in attendance: Donald Alcombright, Tyler Bouchard, and Jessica Kramer.

Staff Present: Keith Hickey, Town Administrator, Gloria Mitchell, Assistant Town Administrator and Patricia Tucker, Assistant to the Town Administrator.

**8:30 AM** – Call to Order by Roll Call Vote

Discussion of Articles on Annual Town Meeting Warrant

Ms. Emberg asked the Board if there was any article they wanted to discuss. There was no discussion.

Discussion on Proposed Town Meeting Warrant Amendments

Mr. Hickey explained each of the three amendments to the Board. The first, Article 20, Purchase of Land, the landowner signed an agreement for \$200,000 but as the Board initially voted on \$175,000 the Board needed to vote on whether or not they support the increase from the initial amount.

Motion by Mr. Bouchard, second by Mr. Alcombright and a 4-0-0 vote, by roll call vote

VOTE: I move to approve the proposed increase of Article 20, Purchase of Land to \$200,000

Ms. Vaughn joined the meeting.

For the articles below no Board members made a motion to change any of their standing votes, despite the adjustments to Article 22, which changed to allow the Recreation Department to apply for a grant for the Grays Beach Playground project, and Article 27, which increased the cost on the Pump out Boat Motor but still would be funded by the Waterways funds which is paid by user fees.

- Proposed Amendment to the Language of Article 22, Gray's Beach Playground
- Proposed Increase of Article 27, Replace Pump out Boat Motor

Motion by Mr. Alcombright, second by Mr. Bouchard and a 5-0-0 vote,
